

Be BBQ SAFE this Summer

BBQ Safety Tips

- Use alcohol responsibly around BBQ's
- Remove any flammables surrounding the BBQ and place in a well ventilated area before lighting
- Install a safety gas shut-off valve that activates when a leak occurs
- Only use refilled gas cylinders that are within the 10-year test period
- Inspect the cylinder and all connections for damage, use soapy water to check for gas leaks
- If a gas leak does occur, shut off the cylinder immediately and allow any gas to dissipate
- Consider having a fire extinguisher or water hose nearby
